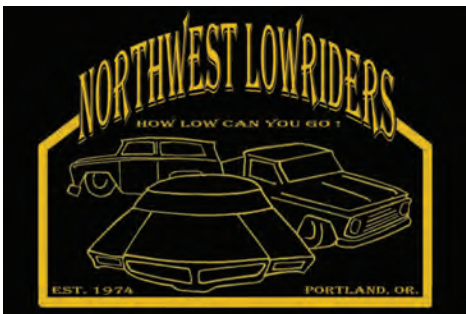
The summer events are now officially off and running and it looks to be an outstanding summer for getting your cars out for cruising, supporting the
